SCHEDULE "B" - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

A designated employee is not required to disclose that he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or holds any position of management in a business entity. However, a designated employee who holds such a position is still subject to the disqualification provisions of Section 500 of this Code with respect to such position.

CATEGORY 1

Any investment, interest in real property located within the City of Los Angeles, or income, as defined in this Code.

CATEGORY 2

- A. Any investment, as defined by Code;
- B. Any interest in real property, as defined by this Code, located within the City of Los Angeles;
- C. Any income, as defined by this Code, from any person or business entity which:
 - 1. Does or during the past 12 months did business in or with the City of Los Angeles.
 - 2. Owns or during the past 12 months owned an interest in real property located within the City of Los Angeles not used principally as a residence;
- D. Income herein includes income from any person required to register pursuant to Sec. 48.01 et seq. of the LAMC (Legislative Advocate Ordinance).

CATEGORY 3

Any investment in or income from any person or business entity, as defined in this Code, which manufactures, distributes, sells, installs, constructs, or otherwise furnishes electrical equipment, assemblies or supplies in the City of Los Angeles.

CATEGORY 4

Any investment in or income from any person or business entity, as defined in this Code, which manufactures, distributes, sells, installs, constructs or otherwise furnishes plumbing equipment, assemblies or supplies in the City of Los Angeles.

CATEGORY 5

Income from any individual who is or during the last twelve months was, employed in the Training Division or who has applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 6

- A. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity, as defined in this Code, which manufactures, distributes, sells, installs, constructs or otherwise furnishes plumbing equipment, assemblies or supplies in the City of Los Angeles.
- B. Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Mechanical Testing Laboratory or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 7

- A. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity, as defined in this Code, which manufactures, distributes, sells, installs, constructs, or otherwise furnishes electrical equipment, assemblies, or supplies in the City of Los Angeles.
- B. Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Electrical Testing Laboratory or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 8

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Administrative Services Division or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 9

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed on the staff of the Building and Safety Commission or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 10

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Financial Services Section of the Administrative Services Division or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 11

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the General Analysis and Budget Services Section of the Administrative Services Division or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 12

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Department of Building and Safety or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 13

Income from any individual who is, or during the past twelve months was, employed by the Clerical Support Division of the Bureau of Community Safety or who applied for a position therein during said period.

CATEGORY 14

- A. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which filed any application for a permit, approval or other similar relief relating to foundation engineering or geology, which application is, or during the past twelve months was, pending before the Building and Safety Commission and/or the Housing Advisory and Appeal Board.
- B. Any interest in real property with regard to which any application for a permit, approval or other similar relief relating to foundation engineering or geology, is, or during the past twelve months was, pending before the Building and Safety Commission and/or the Housing Advisory and Appeal Board.
- C. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which owns an interest in real property located within 500 feet of any land with regard to which any application for a permit, approval or other similar relief relating to foundation engineering or geology is, or during the past twelve months was, pending before the Building and Safety Commission and/or the Housing Advisory and Appeal Board.
- D. Any interest in real property located within 500 feet of any land with regard to which any application for a permit, approval or other similar relief relating to foundation engineering or geology is, or during the past twelve months was, pending before the Building and Safety Commission and/or the Housing Advisory and Appeal Board.

CATEGORY 16

- A. Any investment in or income, as defined by this Code, from any person or business entity which manufactures, sells or installs elevator equipment.
- B. Any investment in or income, as defined by this Code, from any person or business entity which owns a building containing elevator equipment or in connection with which an elevator permit was pending during the past twelve months, if the investment or income is related to that building.

- C. Any investment in real property, as defined by this Code located within the City of Los Angeles, other than a leasehold of one or more units therein, on which a building is located containing elevator equipment or in connection with which an elevator permit was pending during the past twelve months.
- D. Elevator equipment, as used herein, means any equipment covered by the City of Los Angeles Elevator Code.

CATEGORY 17

- A. Any investment in or income, as defined by this Code, from any person or business entity which manufactures, sells or installs pressure vessel equipment.
- B. Any investment in or income, as defined by this Code, from any person or business entity which owns a building containing pressure vessel equipment or in connection with which a pressure vessel permit was pending during the past twelve months if the investment or income is related to that building.
- C. Any interest in real property, as defined by this Code, located within the City of Los Angeles, other than a leasehold of one or more units therein, on which a building is located containing pressure vessel equipment or in connection with which a pressure vessel permit was pending during the past twelve months.
- D. Pressure vessel equipment, as used herein, means any equipment covered by the City of Los Angeles Boiler and Unfired Pressure Vessel Code.
