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SCHEDULE "B" - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

GENERAL PROVISION

A designated employee is required to disclose that he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holds any position of management in a business entity if he or she would be required to disclose income from that entity. Income includes loans and gifts.

CATEGORY 1

Any investment, interest in real property located within the City of Los Angeles, or not more than one-half mile outside the boundaries of the City, or income, as defined by this Code.

CATEGORY 2

- A. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity engaged in auditing or accounting services.
- B. Any income from any organization or organization subcontractor which currently receives or during the past two years received or applied for any grant reviewed, approved, administered or audited by the Community Development Department.
- C. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity engaged in architectural or construction contracting in the City of Los Angeles.
- D. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which sells or appraises real estate in the City of Los Angeles.
- E. Any interest in real property, other than residential property, located within the City of Los Angeles or not more than one-half mile outside the boundaries of the City.

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
