

SCHEDULE B - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

GENERAL PROVISION

A designated employee is required to disclose that he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or holds any position of management in a business entity if he or she would be required to disclose income from that entity. Income includes loans and gifts.

CATEGORY 1

Any investment, interest in real property, income, or business position.

CATEGORY 2

A. Any investment.

B. Any interest in real property.

C. Any income or business position, with the exception of any gifts received from any person or business entity which does not and has not for the past twelve months resided in nor done business in or with the City of Los Angeles, nor owned an interest in real property within the jurisdiction.

CATEGORY 3

A. Any investment; provided, however that no investment in a business entity shall be considered an investment solely by reason of the ownership by the business entity of an interest in real property located more than two miles outside the boundaries of the City of Los Angeles.

B. Any interest in real property located within the City of Los Angeles or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the City.

C. Any income or business position with the exception of gifts received from any person or business entity which does not and has not for the past twelve months resided in nor done business in or with the City of Los Angeles, nor owned an interest in real property within the City of Los Angeles or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the City.

CATEGORY 4

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which filed a claim for money, damages or other relief against the City of Los Angeles which is being or during the past twelve months was assigned to the person's division in the Civil Liability Management Branch or any attorney or law firm that represents those persons or entities.

B. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which currently is or during the past twelve months was a party to any litigation assigned to the person's division in the Civil Liability Management Branch or any attorney or law firm that represents those persons or entities.

C. Any investment in, income from or business position with any insurance company, with the exception of any such company which issues only title insurance.

D. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to court reporting services, expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

CATEGORY 5

A. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which currently is or during the past twelve months was a party to any litigation assigned the Civil Liability Management Branch or the Civil Liability Appeals Division.

B. Any investment in, income from or business position with any insurance company, with the exception of any such company which issues only title insurance.

C. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which provides printing and/or filing services for appellate briefs.

CATEGORY 6

A. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any business entity which has marketable stocks or bonds currently outstanding.

B. Any interest in real property.

C. Income from any active member of one of the retirement or pension plan systems.

D. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any financial

institution, investment advisor or stock/commodities broker.

CATEGORY 7

- A. Any investment, income or business position, as defined by this Code.
- B. Any interest in real property located on or within two miles of land which is under the jurisdiction of the Harbor Department.
- C. Any interest in real property which is zoned for industrial uses and which is located within the City of Los Angeles or within two miles of the boundaries of the City.

CATEGORY 8

Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which does business with the Harbor Department or uses Harbor Department property, and is either the subject of investigation by the Harbor Department or is now or within the past twelve months was a party to a legal proceeding (whether administrative or judicial) involving the Harbor Department.

CATEGORY 9

Any investment in, income from or business positions with a person or business entity which:

- A. Leases, sells, repairs, or provides office or business equipment or furniture;
- B. Sells or provides other office supplies;
- C. Publishes or sells law books, legal reference or legal educational materials; or
- D. Leases, sells or provides automated legal research equipment or services.

CATEGORY 10

Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which:

- A. Leases, sells, repairs or provides office or business equipment or furniture;
- B. Sells or provides other office supplies;
- C. Provides court reporter or other legal support services;
- D. Publishes or sells law books, legal reference or legal educational materials; or

F. Leases, sells or provides automated legal research equipment or services.

CATEGORY 11

A. Income from any support staff employee of the division or other unit of the Office of the City Attorney whom he or she supervises.

B. Income from any employee organization which represents employees whom he or she supervises.

C. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity engaged in consulting services with respect to employment standards.

CATEGORY 12

A. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which filed a claim for money, damages or other relief against the City of Los Angeles which is being or during the past twelve months was processed by the Water and Power Division.

B. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which is or during the past twelve months was a party to any litigation assigned to the Water and Power Division.

C. Any investment in, income from or business positions with an insurance company, with the exception of any such company which issues only title insurance.

D. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to court reporter services, expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, copying services, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

CATEGORY 13

Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity, including governmental, nonprofit and for profit entity, which now or during the past twelve months was engaged in providing services for victims of crime.

CATEGORY 13A

Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity, including governmental, nonprofit and for profit entity, which now or during the past twelve months was engaged in providing services for victims of domestic violence.

CATEGORY 13B

Any investment in, income from or business positions with a social service agency including governmental, nonprofit and for profit entities which now or during the past twelve months was engaged in providing services for the elderly.

CATEGORY 14

Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which:

- A. Manufactures, sells, rents or distributes educational audio-visual equipment;
- B. Manufactures, sells, rents or supplies office or courtroom equipment or furniture;
- C. Publishes or sells law books or legal educational materials;
- D. Provides training or education for attorneys;
- E. Seeks to influence any legislation sponsored by the Office of the City Attorney.

CATEGORY 15

A. Income from any employee of the City of Los Angeles or from a member of the immediate family of such employee.

B. Income from any employee organization which represents or seeks to represent employees of the City of Los Angeles.

C. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity engaged in consulting services with respect to employment standards.

D. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

E. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which is now or during the past twelve months was a party to litigation assigned to the Labor Relations Division.

CATEGORY 16

- A. Any investment, income or business position, as defined by this Code.

B. Any interest in real property located on or within two miles of land which is under the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles World Airports Department.

CATEGORY 17

A. Income from any employee of or applicant for employment with the Department of Water and Power, or from a member of the immediate family of such employee or applicant.

B. Income from any employee organization which represents or seeks to represent employees of the Department of Water and Power.

C. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity engaged in consulting services with respect to employment practices.

D. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to court reporter services, expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, copying services, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

CATEGORY 18

A. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which may:

1. contract to provide personnel services to the Office of the City Attorney;
2. lease, sell or otherwise provide published employment tests;
3. sell or otherwise provide psychological consulting service;
4. provide testing services or background investigation services;
5. provide training services under contract or letter of agreement;
6. provide facilities or services for the conduct of conferences, seminars or other training; or
7. provide an advertising service in the form of newspaper or magazine space or artistic lay-out and printing of recruitment brochures.

B. Income from any employee of the Office of the City Attorney or from a member of the immediate family of such employee.

CATEGORY 19

Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which leases, sells, installs, repairs, maintains or provides computer hardware, software or services.

CATEGORY 20

A. Income from any employee of the City of Los Angeles or from a member of the immediate family of such employee.

B. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which is a physician or medical services group doing business in the City of Los Angeles.

C. Any investment in income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides court reporting, copying, private investigation or messenger services in the City of Los Angeles.

CATEGORY 21

A. Income from any employee of the Department of Water and Power or from a member of the immediate family of such employee.

B. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to court reporter services, expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, copying services, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

CATEGORY 22

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which filed a claim for money, damages or other relief against the City of Los Angeles that is or during the past twelve months was assigned to the Water & Power Division.

B. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which filed is a party to the litigation that is or within the past twelve months was assigned to the Water & Power Division.

C. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which is or during the last twelve months was a party to a contract to which the Department of Water & Power is also a party or submitted a bid or proposal on such a contract.

D. Any interest in real property located within two miles of real property in which the Department of Water & Power owns an interest.

CATEGORY 23

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which is or during the past twelve months was a customer of the Department of Water & Power.

B. Any interest in real property which is served by the Department of Water & Power.

C. Any investment in, income from or business positions with any person or business entity which provides litigation support services, including but not limited to court reporter services, expert witnesses, scientific, technical or economic consultants, copying services, investigators, or persons or entities which prepare trial exhibits and similar litigation aids.

CATEGORY 24

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which filed a claim for money, damages or other relief against the City of Los Angeles relating to water, utility rates, or environment issues (including, but not limited to, toxic or environmental cleanup) that is or during the past twelve months was assigned to the Department of Water & Power ("DWP").

B. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which is a party to the litigation relating to water, utility rates, or environment issues (including, but not limited to, toxic or environmental cleanup) that is or within the past twelve months was assigned to DWP.

C. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which is or during the last twelve months was a party to a contract to which the DWP is also a party or submitted a bid or proposal on such a contract.

D. Any interest in real property within two miles of property owned, used or operated by DWP (including, but not limited to, property which DWP has ever used or disposed of toxic materials or any interest in real property within two miles of a site where DWP has ever used or disposed of toxic materials).

CATEGORY 25

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which does business with the City Attorney's Office through the provision of services or goods.

B. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which filed a claim for money, damages or other relief against the City Attorney's Office.

C. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity that provides grant funding to the City Attorney's Office.

CATEGORY 26

A. Any investment in, income from or business position with any person or business entity which does business with the City Attorney's Office through the provision of services or goods.

B. Income from any employee of the Office of the City Attorney or from a member of the immediate family of such employee.

CATEGORY 27

Any investment in, income from or business position with the following:

A. Any trade association of grocers or any person or business entity that engages in the retail sale of tobacco products.

B. Any public health organization that has taken a position on tobacco legislation.

C. Manufacturers and wholesalers of tobacco products.

CATEGORY 28

A. Income from any employee whom he or she supervises.

B. Income from any employee organization which represents employees whom he or she supervises.
