REVISED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE
SCHEDULE B - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

GENERAL PROVISION

A designated employee is required to disclose that he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holds any position of management in a business entity if he or she would be required to disclose income from that entity. Income includes loans and gifts.

CATEGORY 1

- A. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which manufactures, leases, sells, or distributes emergency equipment.
- B. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which provides emergency preparedness training.
- C. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which provides, proposes to provide, or during the past 12 months provided or proposed to provide personal or consulting services for the Emergency Preparedness Department.
- D. Any income from any individual who is currently employed, seeking employment, or during the past 12 months was employed or sought employment with the Emergency Preparedness Department.

CATEGORY 2

- A. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which manufactures, leases, sells, or distributes emergency equipment.
- B. Any investment in or income from any person or business entity which provides emergency preparedness training.

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
