SCHEDULE "B" - DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

**GENERAL PROVISION**

A designated employee is required to disclose that he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or holds any position of management in a business entity if he or she would be required to disclose income from that entity. Income includes loans and gifts.

**CATEGORY 1**

- A. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in collecting or disposing of solid resources, in operating sanitary landfills, in recycling or processing solid resources, or in metering, sampling, testing or processing industrial wastes.
- B. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which disposes of industrial waste.
- C. Any interest in real property in the City of Los Angeles, or within two miles of its boundary lines, which may foreseeably be utilized as a sanitary landfill, solid resources transfer station or a service facility as indicated on a list of potential sites on file in the Bureau of Sanitation office.
- D. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized wastewater treatment maintenance equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in constructing, repairing or cleaning sewers, storm drains, catch basins, pumping plants or other appurtenant structures.
- E. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in treating and processing wastewater or in repairing wastewater treatment facilities.
- F. Income from any individual who is or during the past twelve months was employed by the Bureau of Sanitation, or who applied for such employment during said period.

**CATEGORY 2**

- A. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in collecting or disposing of solid resources, in operating sanitary landfills, in recycling or processing solid resources, or in metering, sampling, testing or processing industrial wastes.
- B. Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which disposes of industrial waste.
- C. Any interest in real property in the City of Los Angeles, or within two miles of its boundary lines, which may foreseeably be utilized as a sanitary landfill, solid resources transfer station or a service facility as indicated on a list of potential sites on file in the Bureau of Sanitation office.

**CATEGORY 3**

Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized wastewater treatment maintenance equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in constructing, repairing or cleaning sewers, storm drains, catch basins, pumping plants or other appurtenant structures.

**CATEGORY 4**

Any investment in, income from, or business positions with any person or business entity which manufactures, sells, services or repairs specialized equipment or provides specialized professional services or materials utilized in treating and processing wastewater or in repairing wastewater treatment facilities.
