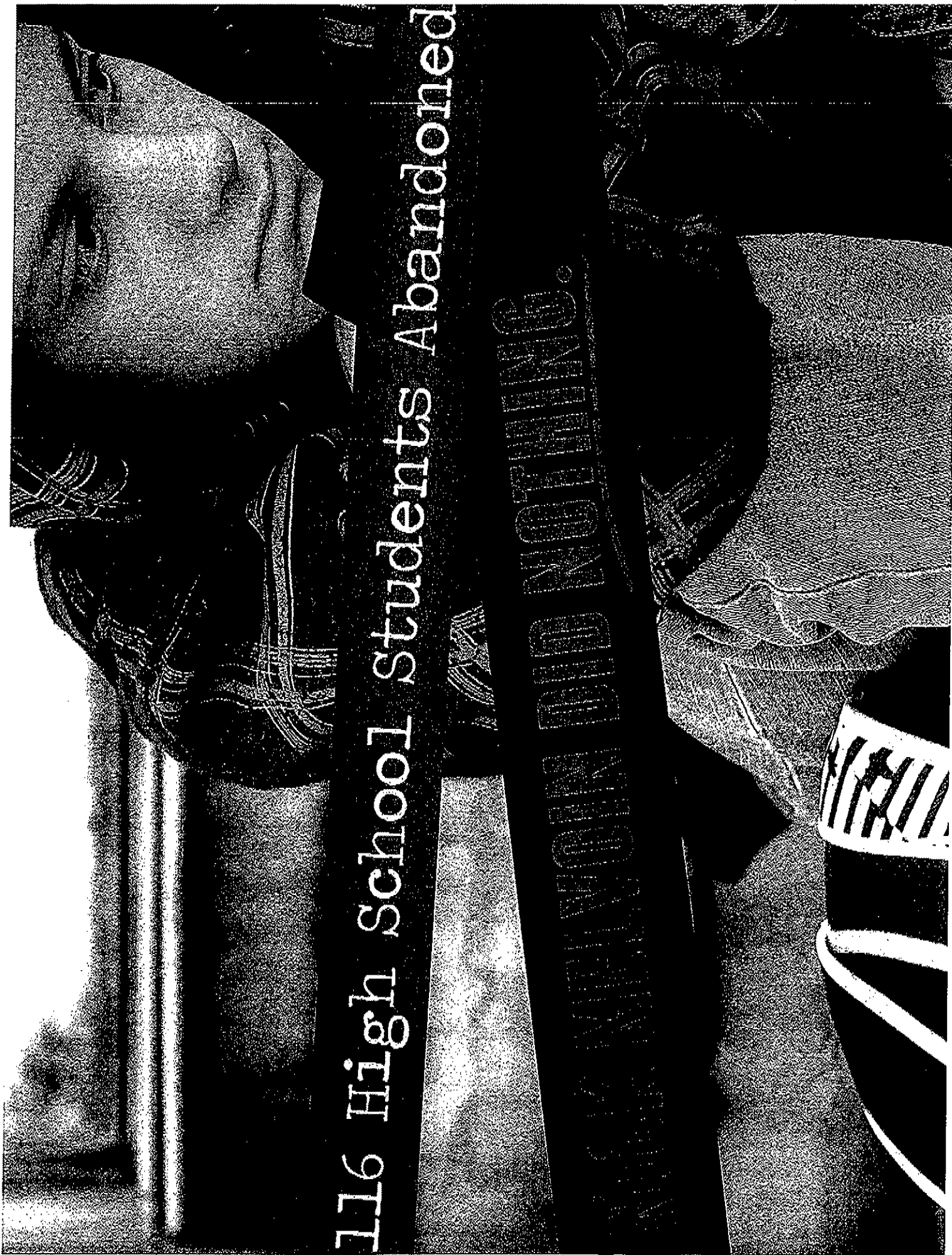

What happens to 116 high school students when their charter school closes a month into the year 9/16/2016



Nick Melvoin is a School Board Director for City Charter Schools, a network of controversial charter schools in Los Angeles that opened a new high school in 2015, only to close it the very next year.<sup>1</sup>

The shutdown left City High's 116 students "scrambling" to find new schools. 91% were students of color.<sup>2</sup>
