While Los Angeles families are struggling, Eric Garcetti is putting himself first. As City Council President, Garcetti voted to cut funding for the fire department, increasing 911 response rates for Angelenos.¹ When he should have been looking out for us, Garcetti was investigated by the Ethics Commission for accepting tickets to awards shows and galas.² He took money away from pothole and road repair to pay for more personal staff, and he stayed in five-star hotels and paid for seven cars – all with city funds.³ And Garcetti also voted to cut funding for parks and libraries while opposing a plan to cut the City Hall office budgets for the Mayor and Council members by 25 percent.⁴
