FUNDRAISING WINDOW OPENS FOR LAUSD SPECIAL ELECTION

The Ethics Commission announced today that the candidate fundraising window has opened for a special election to fill the District 1 vacancy on the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education (LAUSD).

Individuals may now file paperwork with the Ethics Commission to begin fundraising for their campaigns in the special election. Prospective candidates may not solicit or receive campaign contributions until the required paperwork has been filed. In addition, campaign contributions to a single candidate may not exceed \$1,100 per person per election.

The special primary election will take place on June 3, 2014. If no candidate receives a majority of the vote, a special run-off election will take place on August 12, 2014. A City ordinance calling the special election became effective today and was adopted in response to a request from LAUSD.
