Ethics Commission Approves Full Funding for Matching Funds Participants

The Los Angeles City Ethics Commission determined today that the Public Matching Campaign Funds Trust Fund is sufficient to provide the maximum matching funds to qualified participating candidates in the regular 2013 primary election. Qualified participating candidates will be eligible to receive up to 100 percent of the maximums established by City law.

The maximum matching funds a qualified participating candidate may receive in the regular 2013 primary election are:

Mayoral candidates:	\$667,000
City Attorney candidates:	\$300,000
Controller candidates:	\$267,000
City Council candidates:	\$100,000

Only those participating candidates who are certified to appear on the ballot and meet the program's qualifications will be eligible to receive public matching funds.

The City Ethics Commission was created by Los Angeles voters in 1990 to impartially administer and enforce the governmental ethics, campaign financing, and lobbying laws of the City of Los Angeles.
