FUNDRAISING WINDOWS OPEN FOR THE 2015 PRIMARY ELECTIONS

The Ethics Commission announced today that the fundraising windows for the 2015 City and Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education (LAUSD) primary elections have opened. The election will take place on March 3, 2015, and all even-numbered City Council districts and odd-numbered LAUSD districts will be on the ballot.

Individuals who are interested in becoming candidates in the 2015 elections may now file the required paperwork with the Ethics Commission. Fundraising documents must be filed with the Ethics Commission before a candidate or committee may solicit or receive contributions for a campaign for City or LAUSD office.

There are limits on the amount of money a single person may contribute to City and LAUSD candidates. For the 2015 elections, the per-person limits are \$700 for City Council candidates and \$1,100 for LAUSD candidates.

The City Ethics Commission was created by Los Angeles voters in 1990 to impartially administer and enforce the City's governmental ethics, campaign financing, and lobbying laws.
